Thankfully, out of all the residents who got it only two had to seek a doctor's care and all are recovered now. While we were down and ministry seemed to not be happening the way it should, God was still working, calling people out of the darkness and into the light of His Son. So, it is with great joy that I get to report that we had two baptisms at the Mission this month.

Whitney had started abusing pain pills at the age of 19 and then quickly graduated to heroin and methamphetamine. She was stuck in a cycle of addiction, bad relationships and couch surfing for more than ten years. What had already been bad became even worse when her father passed away and she entered into another relationship that became severely abusive. Then DHS took her son Connor from her.

When Whitney came to the Mission almost two months ago she absolutely surrendered her will and her life over to Jesus Christ in a way I have never seen before. She knew nothing about God or Jesus before she came here. But she knew one thing, she needed a savior and she needed to repent from the life that she had been living. So she removed everything and everybody from her life that was toxic, did everything that was asked of her and asked questions continually about the Word and also about Jesus.

Within just a few short weeks DHS returned her son Connor to her. Then she came to me one day and said I want to be baptized. I am honored and blessed to get to be a part of one of Gods miracles and witness such an amazing transformation. During her baptism I read Psalm 32. Psalm 32:5
